This design combines the best features of our Florida Bay Coaster designs (roomy, comfortable living quarters) with an easily driven hull for economy of operation on longer cruising.

We've added some length to this design to give very generous deck spaces for outdoor living. As anyone who has lived aboard for many years knows, these open deck spaces are very important and get a lot of use. The walk-around upper decks add greatly to her practicality & functionality.

The pilothouse has raised seating for the crew to join the helmsman. The after corners of the pilothouse are notched for stairs up to the boat deck.

The master stateroom has a full head, king-sized bed and generous storage. The forward two guest or children's staterooms share the head between them.

The family room style saloon, with galley and dining in it, is well proven as a practical solution. All in all, a great little ship for living aboard.
